North porch entrance, pre-repair.

- North porch, main entrance to the building.
- Roof tiles are dangerously loose, missing rain water goods, rotting timber work.
- Real H&S concerns with the potential of slipping tiles.

- TRP Grant of £5443.00.
- Re-roofing of the porch using the original clay tiles and carrying out timber repairs.
- Improving drainage and preventing internal damp with the addition of new rain water goods.
- The main entrance is now stable providing secure access.
- Churchwardens received a maintenance coaching and are encouraged to set up a robust and regular maintenance plan for the fabric.
